DECISION ON THE FALLSTON HIGH SCHOOL RE-ROOFING CONTRACT

June 28, 2010

Background Information:

The Purchasing Department, on behalf of the Planning and Construction Department is requesting a decision by the Board of Education to award a contract to Centennial Contractors Enterprises, Inc., of Baltimore, MD, to furnish all labor, material and equipment to re-roof a section of roof underneath the existing patio at Fallston High School.

Discussion:

Due to the nature of the work required, a decision was made to use the on-call Job Order Contracts (JOC). Based on a specific scope of work, proposals were solicited from two Job Order Contractors. Pricing proposals were submitted and approved. The total lump sum all inclusive pricing is as follows:

Centennial Contractors	\$ 101,493.00
Hess Construction	\$ 169,652.00

Both JOC's were given an MBE Goal of 15% for this project. Centennial Contractors Enterprises, Inc. advises that they have a goal of 20% minority business participation on this project in accordance with IAC and State of Maryland minority business enterprise procedures.

Superintendent's Recommendation:

The Superintendent of Schools recommends that the Board of Education approve a contract for the above described roof repair project at Fallston High School in the amount of \$101,493.00 to Centennial Contractors Enterprises, Inc.
