Our signatures at the bottom of this sheet indicate our willingness to observe the rules and regulations listed below and those listed on the Application for Use of School Facilities which is attached.

A. All individuals, groups, and/or organizations are expected to comply with the pool regulations which follow:

- 1. The school is not responsible for the loss of clothing and valuables.
2. There is to be no one in the pool area without a lifeguard on duty.
3. All swimmers must take a shower before entering the pool area.
4. Street shoes are prohibited on the deck area.
5. Bathing caps, short hair, or long hair tightly secured are required.
6. Food or beverage is not permitted in the pool and bleacher area.
7. Smoking is prohibited in the pool and locker and bleacher areas, as well as throughout the building.
8. Running, shoving, and other similarly dangerous activities are prohibited.
9. Lifeguards may request anyone to take a swimming test to determine the swimmer's ability and where he may swim. Usually swimmers must swim two widths of the pool before entering any area above shoulder depth.
10. Special equipment (breathing apparatus, nose clips, ear plugs, floats, etc.) may be used only with the permission of a Certified Red Cross Water Safety Instructor.

11. Procedures to safely use the diving board include:

- a. consulting the diagramatic sketch which indicates the depth and slope of the diving well
b. permitting only one diver on the board at a time
c. diving in a straight line from the board only
d. refraining from hanging on the diving board.

When the diving board is in use, swimming is prohibited in the diving area.

12. All non-swimmers under 48 inches in height must be accompanied by an adult while in the pool.

13. No swimmer shall use the pool when he has:

- a. a communicable or infectious disease
b. sore or inflamed eyes
c. nasal or ear discharge or a serious cold
d. a skin disease

All swimmers with bandages, open wounds, and/or sores must obtain approval to swim from the pool supervisor prior to entering the pool.

B. All persons not in appropriate swimming attire must remain in the bleacher area. Neither food nor beverage is permitted in the bleacher or pool area.

C. A maximum of 80 participants will be permitted in the pool area per session. Exceptions may be granted, at the discretion of the approving authorities, for unusual circumstances for which adequate justification and appropriate safeguards are provided.

- D. The responsible adult group supervisor as identified on this form must be present at all times while the pool is in use and shall enforce the pool regulations.
- E. Locker room security is the responsibility of the using group.
- F. A minimum of one approved pool supervisor with a current Water Safety Instructor's Certificate and one lifeguard with the American Red Cross Advanced Lifesaving Certificate must be on duty at all times. The names of both the supervisor and the lifeguard must be on the approved lists of supervisors or lifeguards in the office of the principal.

- G. The supervisor of the using group will be responsible for determining before departing that:
1. the locker rooms are left in a clean and orderly condition;
 2. the deck area is clean;
 3. all equipment has been returned to its designated place.
- H. In case of emergency or any unusual circumstance, the school principal or his designee is to be notified immediately.
- I. The Board of Education reserves the right to make any and all other regulations which might become necessary and which are in the best interest of the school system.
