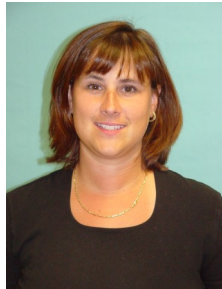


# Mrs. Gray's Third Grade Class - 2009—2010
