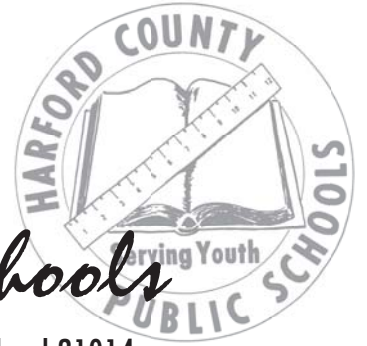

****NOTE:** This calendar contains the potential for 186 student days – six more than the state minimum requirement of 180 days. The six days may be used as make-up days for any days lost to inclement weather or other emergencies. Any of the four days listed at the end of the school year (*June 11, 12, 13, and 14) not needed as inclement weather/emergency make-up days will be dropped and the last day of the school year will be adjusted accordingly. In addition, if a fifth inclement weather/emergency make-up day is needed, Tuesday, April 3* will be used; if a sixth make-up day is needed, Monday, April 2* will be used. The school year will not exceed 180 days for students and 190 days for teachers.
