Major factors used to calculate County's share of Maryland State Aid

- County Wealth funding distributed by formulas inversely proportional to local district wealth (personal property, income & real property for railroads, utilities, businesses and individuals)
- Enrollment funding adjusted based on per pupil formula for changes in enrollment
- **Geographic Cost of Education Index** is a discretionary formula that accounts for differences in the costs of educational resources among the local school systems
 - 13 of 24 LEAs will share \$131 million of GCEI funding for FY 2014
 - Harford County does <u>not</u> receive GCEI funding
- Guaranteed Tax Base provides additional funding to LEAs with less than 80% of statewide wealth per pupil and a contribution of more than the minimum required local share under the foundation program in the prior fiscal year
 - 9 of 24 LEAs qualify for the funding for FY 2014
 - Harford County does <u>not</u> receive GTB funding
- **Supplemental Grants** enacted in a 2007 special legislative session to mitigate the impact of an inflation freeze in the per pupil foundation in fiscal 2009 & 2010
 - 9 of 24 LEAs receive a share of the \$46.5 million fixed grant
 - Harford County does <u>not</u> receive a share

Wealth Factor - Impact on HCPS FY14 State Aid

<u>Total Wealth</u> - funding distributed by formulas inversely proportional to local district wealth

- » Of 24 LEAs only one, Howard County, experienced a positive change in total wealth (addendum 1)
- » The other 23 LEAs experienced a decline in total wealth Harford County experienced the smallest decline (.01%) (addendum 2)
- » Total Wealth in Past Five Years (addendum 3) State Wide - Decreased 5% Harford County - Increased 3%



Wealth -vs- Enrollment

The impact of the wealth factor in calculating aid can be more easily determined when funding is compared year to year on a **per pupil basis**.

- » Harford County experienced the largest dollar decline in state aid (\$4.1 million) of the 24 jurisdictions.
- » Net revenue reduction due to *Wealth Factor* is (\$3,643,465)
- » Net revenue change due to *Enrollment* Changes is (\$414,799)
