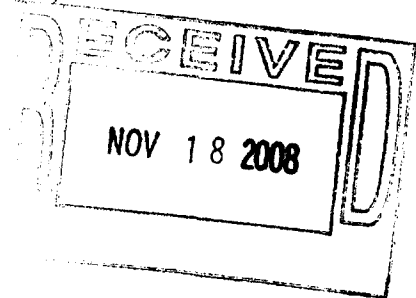

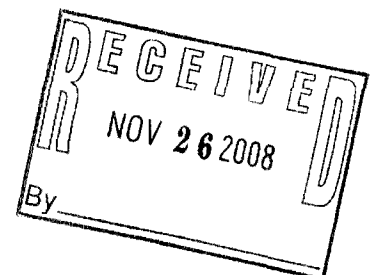
**RE: Trimble Road at Forte Hoyle Road

Dear Property Owner:

This is to follow up on the letter dated June 17, 2008, informing you of Harford County's desire to place a roundabout at the intersection of Trimble and Forte Hoyle Roads to improve safety and traffic flow particularly at peak times of the day. The preliminary design plan has been completed and a copy has been enclosed for your use.

As shown on the preliminary plan, the roundabout is placed between the two entrances of the Cheapeake Community Church and also encroaches on the Board of Education property, site of the Magnolia Schools. The center island of the roundabout will be landscaped and the concrete truck apron will be colorized and stamped with a brick pattern. The project will require us to acquire a portion of your property to construct the roundabout.
