**DECISION ON DISPOSAL OF
LAND, SCHOOL SITES OR BUILDINGS
(POLICY NO.: 20-0021-000)**

November 23, 2009

Background Information:

The Board maintains a manual which sets forth the various policies of the Harford County Public Schools. The manual contains policies which are either required by federal and state law and regulation or which are, in the Board's judgment, necessary and appropriate in order for the school system to operate in a lawful, appropriate and effective manner. Included among such policies is that entitled Disposal of Land, School Sites or Buildings.

Discussion:

This policy is recommended for deletion in its entirety as the policy repeats existing statutory and regulatory language pertaining to Board of Education land, school sites, or buildings no longer needed for school purposes. The Board has stated its intent that policies that repeat federal or state law or regulation are not to be included in the Board Policy Manual.

The above policy was presented at the Board's meeting of October 12, 2009. At that time, a recommendation that the policy be deleted was presented. No public comment was received regarding this policy.
