

At the Monday, July 9, 2007 Board of Education of Harford County meeting, the Board:

Reorganized its leadership positions, in keeping with Board Policy, by electing **Thomas L. Fidler, Jr.** to be President and **Salina M. Williams** to be Vice President for a one-year term. **Mark M. Wolkow**, President of the Board for 2006-07 reflected on his year as the Board's chair and Mr. Fidler discussed his goals for the coming year. Mr. Wolkow assumed the role of Past President for the coming year. In addition, Superintendent **Jacqueline C. Haas** administered the oath of office to the 2007-08 Student Representative to the Board of Education **Chase J. Jackson** of Harford Technical High School.

Conducted a recognition ceremony for the school custodial crews which won the 2006-07 custodial first place awards.

Mr. Wolkow and Dr. Haas took part in ceremonial signing ceremonies with representatives of HCEA (teachers' union) and HCESC (clerical union).

Approved items on the Consent Agenda including Monthly Contract Awards; Approved the Monthly Report on Personnel; Approved the Comprehensive Maintenance Plan; and Approved the Purchase of Playground Equipment.

Changed the name of the Harford County Public Schools Administration Building to the Harford County Public Schools A.A. Roberty Building

Approved the contract award on the scope study for the Youth's Benefit Elementary School modernization in the amount of \$33,965,833, reflecting a 1,000 seat capacity, one-building school to be completed (pending funding) in 2 ½ years.

Approved the schematic design for the replacement of Deerfield Elementary School to be submitted to the Maryland State Department of Education for comments and approval while the design team continues design development.

Approved the schematic design for the replacement of Edgewood High School to be submitted to the Maryland State Department of Education for comments and approval while the design team continues Design Development of the project.

Received a presentation from Alternative Education Program Principal **Mark Buzminsky** on the strategic plan for the future of the program which offers alternative services to students who voluntarily attend the secondary school program or who enroll there after having been suspended from the regular school program.

Letina Green, former special education teacher at Aberdeen Middle School, was promoted from the Assistant Principal 1 Pool to be AP1 at Southampton Middle School. **Jeff Raff** was moved from the AP4 Pool to an AP4 at North Harford Middle School (where he was already serving in a ten-month capacity).

Due to the passing of the 10:00 p.m. curfew for new items to be introduced, the meeting was adjourned at 10:20 p.m.
