
## 2020 Fair Housing Art Contest

### THEME: United We Live

### Contest Criteria

1. The contest is open to students in grades K - 12 and will be judged in the following categories: K-5 (elementary school); 6-8 (middle school); and 9-12 (high school).
2. Schools, home schools, after-care groups, churches, and other children centers in Harford County may participate. To qualify, all artwork must be submitted to the Harford County Association of REALTORS® no later than April 3, 2020. Early submissions are encouraged and appreciated. 3. **OFFICIAL POSTER RULES:**
  - a. Posters must be in landscape format which is 8 ½" high by 11" wide.

  - b. Artwork must be produced in color.
  - c. Any materials may be used. Graphic design computer programs are permitted.
  - d. No licensed characters (Disney, etc.) may be used. Any clip art or stock images used must be free and not copyrighted.
  - e. All entries **MUST** display the **REALTOR® and Fair Housing logos** (found below) **AND** the **theme, "United We Live"**, somewhere in the body of the piece.
  - f. All entries must be labeled on the back. (Attached to this packet are forms that must be completed for every entry.)
4. All winning posters selected by Harford County Association of REALTORS® become the property of the Association and may be reproduced in other industry publications.
