= A Local School System is considered Significantly Disproportionate if the identification of students within a racial or ethnic group for one of more disabilities listed above is equal to or exceeds the 1.5 weighted risk ration AND the percentage of students within a racial or ethnic group who are placed outside of the general education setting for 60 % of the school day exceeds the .20 Index AND the percentage of the students within a racial or ethnic group who are suspended for greater than 10 days or multiple suspensions summing to greater than 10 days exceeds the .20 index.
