

2011-2012 Weather Contingency Plans
For All-County Music Performances

Basic All-County Schedule

- Thursday night rehearsal, 7:00-9:00pm – Students are to report to designated school for rehearsal. Parents are responsible for student’s transportation.
- Friday rehearsal, 10:00am-4:30pm – Buses will transport students to and from home school to rehearsal site. Buses will leave rehearsal site at 4:30pm. Parents should ask the student’s music teacher for an estimated time of arrival to their home school.
- Saturday rehearsal and concert, 10:00am-2:30pm – Students are to report to designated school and ready to practice in time. **They need to bring their concert attire/choral robes with them.** The concert begins at 12:30pm.

Option 1 – Thursday night rehearsal cancellation

Friday and Saturday rehearsals will go on as scheduled, but programming modifications may occur.

Option 2 – Thursday night rehearsal cancellation and Friday 2-hour delay

On Friday, students will be picked up at their home school 2 hours late and will be returned as scheduled beginning at 4:30pm. Saturday morning rehearsal will be extended from 8:00am to 1:00pm. Possible programming modifications may occur.

Option 3 – Thursday night rehearsal and Friday rehearsal cancellations due to school closing

On Saturday, students will report at 9:00am and rehearsal will be held until 5:00pm. Concert programming modifications will be made. Students will bring a packed lunch and drink. Dinner consisting of pizza will be purchased by the music department. **Students must bring their concert attire/choral robes with them.** Concert will be rescheduled to begin at 7:00pm.

Option 4 – Cancellation of Saturday rehearsal and/or concert

In the event that the evening concert must be cancelled, every effort will be made to reschedule.

Option 5 – Unexpected changes in weather

Modifications may be made as needed.

In all cases, students will be expected to attend every minute of every rehearsal to participate in the All-County activity. Students who miss any part of any rehearsal will not be properly prepared to perform with the ensemble.
