



Supplemental Educational Services (SES)

As of March 1, 2012

The term SES refers to extra academic help (tutoring) in subjects, such as reading and mathematics, which is provided to eligible Title I students, enrolled at a Title I school (a school in its second year of School Improvement).

The tutoring is provided by private vendors, otherwise known as SES providers. SES is offered during after-school hours and may take place at the school, in a home, or at another location.

The Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) maintains a list of approved SES providers who provide these services.

Harford County Public Schools (HCPS) has not had to provide SES Services between 2007-2008 through 2010-2011 school years.
