**Children must arrive at their bus stop at least 5 minutes before the scheduled arrival time of the bus. Students should be reminded never to run towards a school bus.**

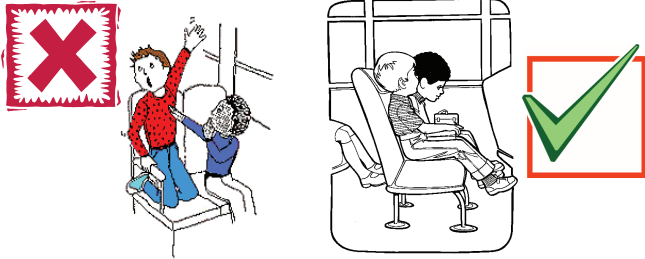


**REMINDE YOUR CHILD NOT TO DISTRACT THE DRIVER'S EYES FROM THE ROAD**

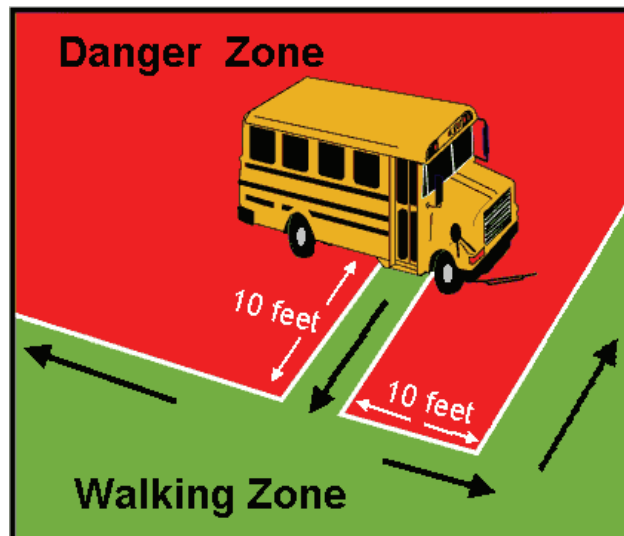
## RIDING THE BUS SAFELY



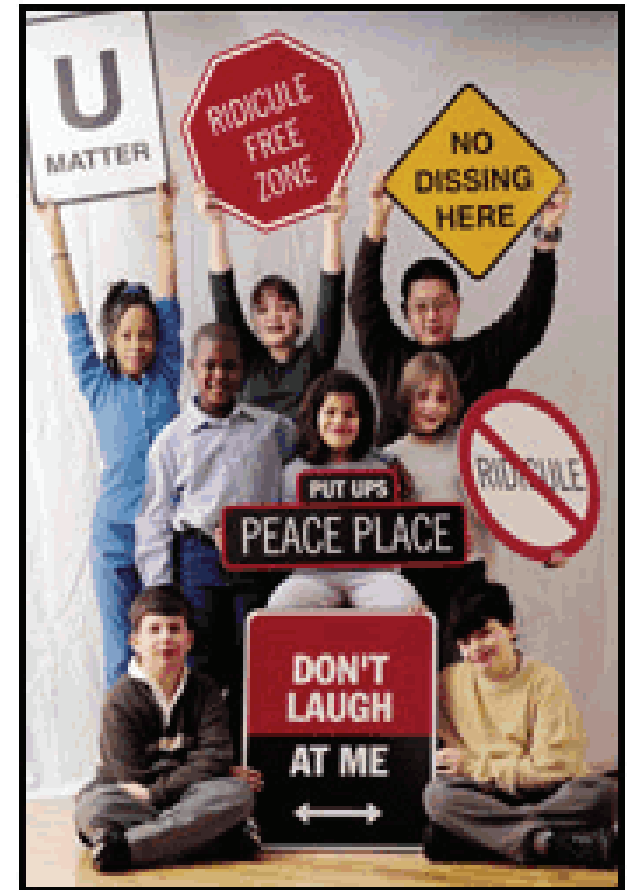
STUDENTS SHOULD BE SEATED FLAT AND BACK
