SUMMARY:**

To help maintain the buildings of the school system in a condition of operating excellence to ensure that full use may be made at all times.

**ESSENTIAL
FUNCTIONS
INCLUDE:**

These are intended only as examples of the various types of job duties to be performed. The omission of specific duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is a similar, related, or logical assignment to the position.

- ▶ Installs, maintains, and diagnoses trouble in boilers, water heaters, expansion tanks, and related equipment.
- ▶ Maintains, services, and installs combustion control equipment and ignition transforms.
- ▶ Renovates heating systems and associated controls, piping, and safety devices; verifies safe operating conditions on all heating units and pressure vessels.
- ▶ Installs, repairs, replaces, and maintains all types of pumps, valves, blowers, controls, and safety devices.
- ▶ Services oil and gas fired burners, related controls, and fuel feed systems.
- ▶ Prepares pressure vessels for state inspections, accompanies inspectors, and corrects violations.
- ▶ Evaluates equipment for necessary adjustments, renovations, or replacement.
- ▶ Assists in the installation of fuel oil tanks and associated piping, pumps, and controls.
- ▶ Responds and assists during emergency situations including, but not limited to, inclement weather assignments, vandalism, and emergency repairs.
- ▶ Performs other work-related duties as assigned.

SALARY:

Grade 9 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME)

REQUIREMENTS:

- ▶ High school diploma or GED.
- ▶ Five years experience in diagnosing, repairing, and replacing commercial or industrial boilers, burners, and associated equipment through 250 horsepower.
- ▶ Hold and maintain a valid driver's license with a willingness to obtain and maintain a commercial driver's license.
- ▶ Must obtain and maintain a Second Grade Stationary Engineer's License.
- ▶ Physically able to perform the essential functions of the position, with or without reasonable accommodations, including opening and closing larger boiler units, replacing burner assemblies, and installing pressure relief valves.
- ▶ Skilled in the use of test equipment, tools, data, and specification sheets of the trade.
- ▶ Must be available to respond to emergencies, including after hour emergencies.
