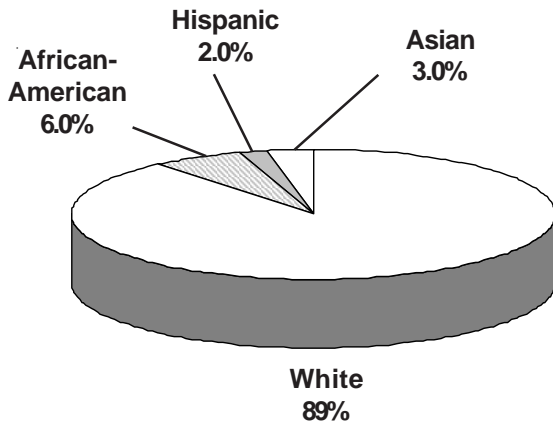

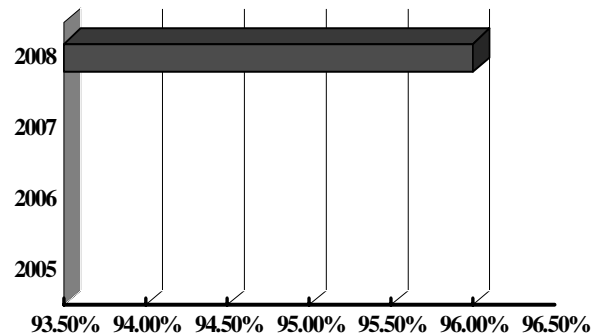

## Student Membership by Ethnicity (2008)

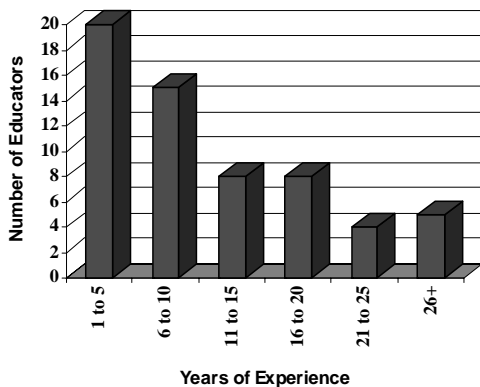

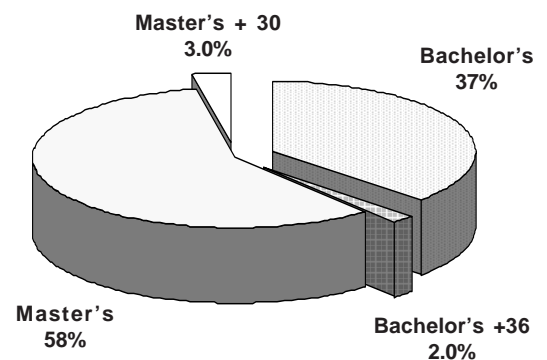

## Professional Staff Experience



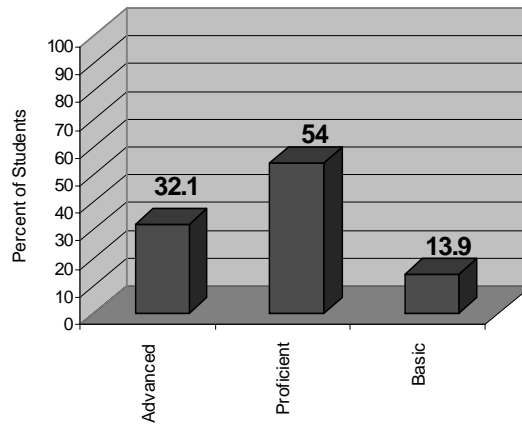

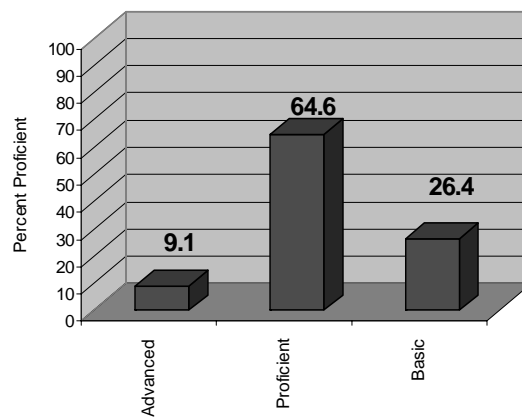
