SHAPE America Announces 2023 District Teachers of the Year in Physical Education, Adapted Physical Education, and Health

RESTON, VA, December 15, 2022 — SHAPE America – Society of Health and Physical Educators today announced its 2023 District Teacher of the Year award recipients, who are being recognized for excellence in physical education, adapted physical education, health education, and dance education.

These outstanding educators — who were all previously recognized as state teachers of the year — have now been selected as the "best of the best" in their category at the district level, representing one of SHAPE America's five districts: Central, Eastern, Midwest, Southern, and Western.

"These incredible teachers epitomize what the Teacher of the Year program is all about – recognizing those who motivate and lead their students to participate in a lifetime of physical activity," says SHAPE America CEO Stephanie Morris.
