This week we continued our “Kid’s Choice” unit. We voted on center & letter game activities and identified symbols of our country. In I.L.A., we began regrouping the children to meet their academic levels. All groups listened for beginning sounds in words; identified story events (beginning, middle, and ending); predicted stories (using titles, illustrations, & prior knowledge); worked with the letter Aa; and reviewed Robusto’s words to date. In our homeroom, we wrote ‘news’ in our writing journals. In math, we created number boards; sorted coins by size and color; and we learned how to tally objects.

Next week, we will continue to discover symbols of our country by learning about the Statue of Liberty, Mt. Rushmore, the American Bald Eagle, and the Liberty Bell. In math, we will be reading, writing, and counting numbers to 20 and we will continue to tally objects.
