Literature: Books, Books, Books!

We have enjoyed reading stories by various authors. While listening to these stories, the students are creating mental images, making connections, asking questions, making predictions and much, much more!



ILA (Integrated Language Arts)-

We are beginning our next theme, "Turning Corners". In this theme, students will recognize story structure. They will continue to compare stories and characters. They will make inferences to answer questions. Students will learn the importance of adjusting their reading rate in order to monitor comprehension. Continue to take time to talk to your child about the strategies they are learning in school to help them become better readers. (The strategies/skills are listed at the top of each week's homework assignment.) And, most importantly, we have finished the first anthology! The children are very proud of their accomplishments. They are on their way to becoming fabulous readers!



Math-

Please continue to work and talk with your child each night. The homework (home-links) provides an opportunity for your child to tell you about their day. We'll continue to make connections with everyday uses for numbers, in particular telling time and counting money! We will also engage in activities to prepare for addition and subtraction, both as computational skills and as tools for problem solving.



Social Studies/ Science-

We will learn about fire safety and make connections to our community. We will meet "Frog" who will show us the importance of belonging and boosting our self esteem. Later this month, we will use our senses to explore the season of fall!



Writing-

We will begin to review proofreading/editing. We will begin sentences with a capital letter and end each with punctuation. We will use the word wall words and vocabulary from our stories to spell words correctly as well as try to write neatly so others can read our work.



(Self Selected Reading) -

We will continue to practice choosing "just right" books to read independently. SSR time encourages students to choose books of high interest (at an appropriate level) to facilitate strategic reading and independent thinking.
