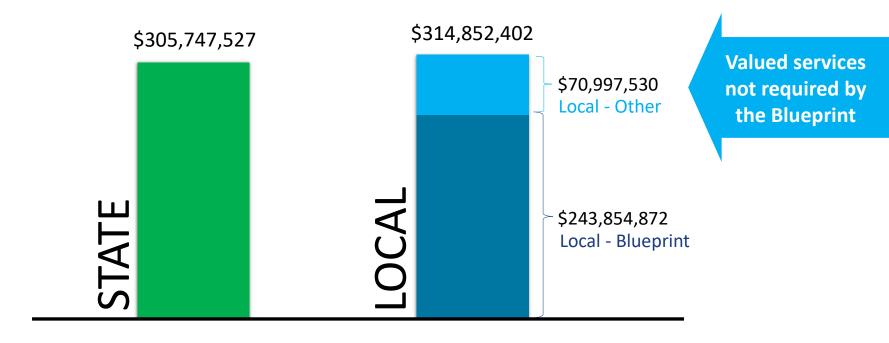

Implementation of Minimum Adequate Funding at 75% per pupil



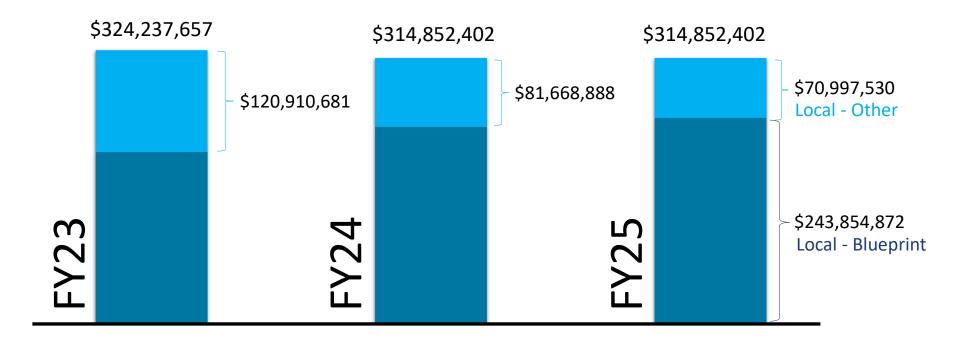
State & Local Revenue



Based on FY 2025 Proposed Budget with Flat Local Funding



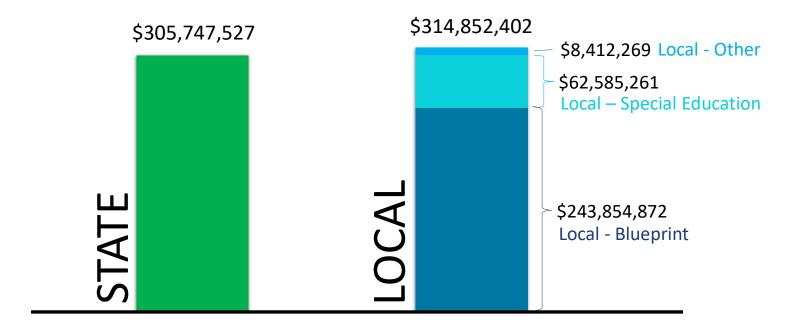
Local Revenue
