This program will prepare students with construction industry skills based on four modules from the NCCER* Core curriculum. Students will participate in hands-on exercises with both hand and power construction tools. Students will also learn basic construction math and how to understand construction drawings, which will prepare students for a job in the industry. By the end of the program, students will meet with representatives from local construction companies to discuss employment requirements and opportunities.

- Introduction to Construction Math
- Introduction to Construction Drawings
