### Logistics (Supply Chain) Professional

The Supply Chain Logistics Professional is a vital member of the supply chain community. This program examines the role of supply chain logistics in the economy and explains the importance of warehousing.

#### **Certified Logistics Associate**

Foundational-level CLA Certificate - focuses on the world of logistics and the global supply chain. Students will examine the logistics environment through training in Information Systems and the 4.0 Technologies. Students will learn safety principles, safe material handling and equipment operations, and quality control principles. Other topics will include work communication, teamwork, and good workplace conduct to solve problems. At the course conclusion students will complete the Certified Logistics Associate assessment based upon MSSC's industry-defined, nationally validated skill standards.

#### **Forklift Training- OPTIONAL**

Students may complete a one-day training that includes both classroom and hands-on training for first-time forklift drivers. Forklift operators move materials over short distances in warehouses, storage yards, factories, and construction sites. Operators need to be familiar with the equipment they are using as they are responsible for the safe movement of their cargo. **It is recommended that students are at least 18 years old and have experience driving a vehicle.** Students must pass a written and practical test. Classes take place on Fridays only, for a one day, 8-hour training session.
