



Who We Are

The Harford County Infants & Toddlers Program, serving children with disabilities birth through age 3, is a countywide system of coordinated, multidisciplinary early intervention services. Through family centered services, parents and caregivers are provided guidance and coaching to help their child be successful at home and in the community.



Who is eligible for services?

1. Children demonstrating a 25 % delay in one or more areas of development.
2. Children demonstrating atypical development in one or more areas of development.
3. Children with a diagnosis placing them at risk for developmental delays.

What services are available?

- Audiology
- Social Worker
- Evaluation
- Family education and support
- Occupational Therapy
- Physical Therapy
- Psychology
- Special Instruction
- Speech/Language Therapy

Services in the Infants and Toddlers Program

Families and the early intervention team collaborate to develop an Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP) focusing on family outcomes.

Services are provided through a family coaching model within the child's natural environment (e.g. home, community) during his/her daily routines and activities.

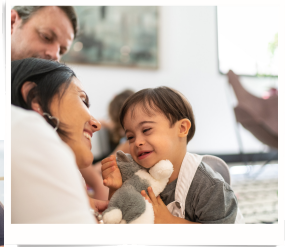


What is the process?

The process begins by making a referral.
