## Drug dog scan conducted at Alternative Education Center

A routine, random drug dog scan was performed at the Alternative Education Center today, December 1<sup>st</sup>. The scan, done as part of the school system's commitment to keeping illicit drugs out of the schools, was accomplished using a canine under the direction of the Harford County Sheriff's Office.

The scan involved 443 lockers being sniffed by the dog. The 20-minute scan – supervised by two Aberdeen Police Officers, one drug dog, two administrators from the school, and the school system's Coordinator of Safety and Security – resulted in two alerts with no controlled dangerous substances found.
