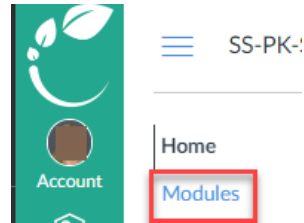
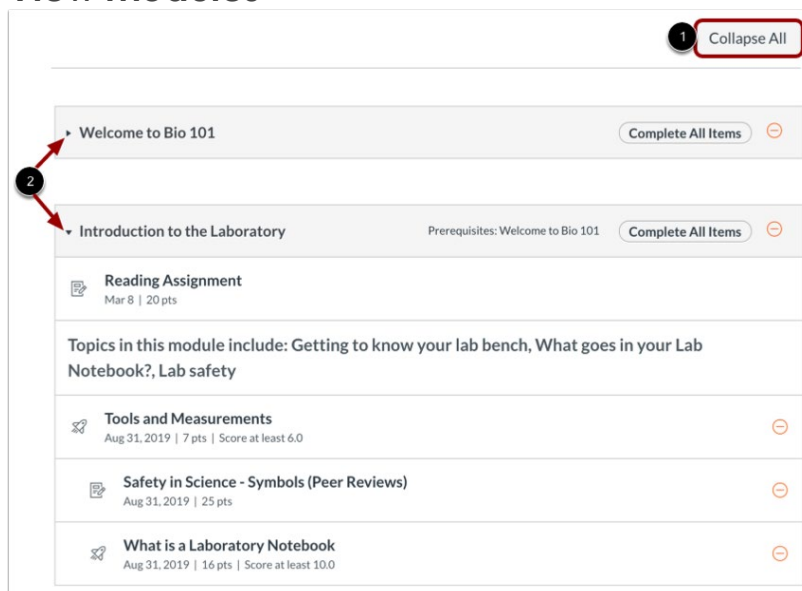


## How do I view Modules as a student?

In Course Navigation, click the **Modules** link.



### View Modules

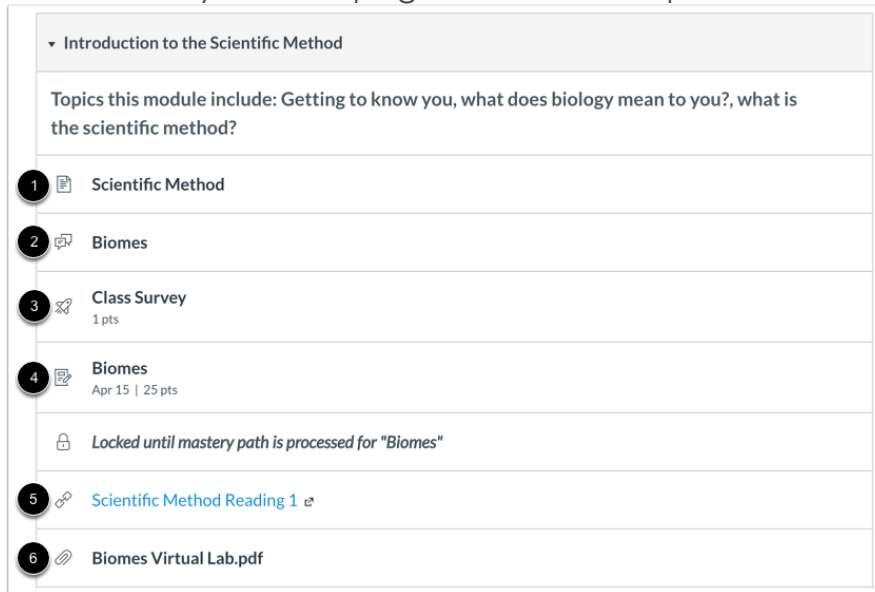


Modules house the content in a course.

To expand or collapse all modules, click the Expand All/Collapse All button [1].

To expand or collapse individual modules, click the module Expand or Collapse arrows [2].

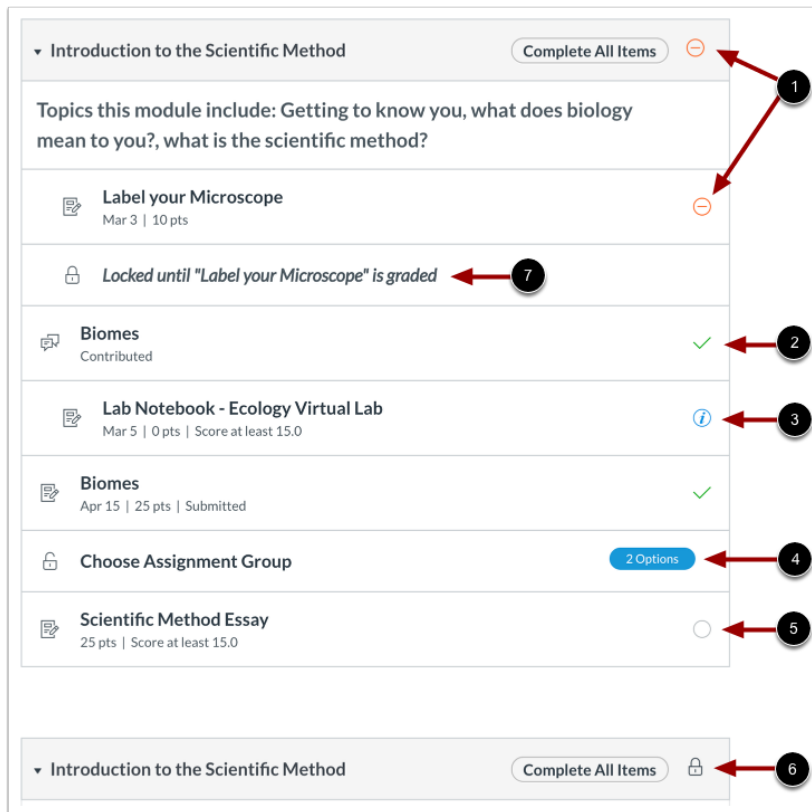
Modules may contain pages, discussions, quizzes, and more.



Below describes the icons in the image above.




1.	<b>Page</b>	a page of content to read
2.	<b>Discussion</b>	a course discussion
3.	<b>Quiz</b>	a course quiz
4.	<b>Assignment</b>	a course assignment
5.	<b>Link or External Tool</b>	an external link or tool to view outside of the course
6.	<b>File</b>	a file to download or view





## View Progression Icons



For any module icon, you can hover over the icon and view the message for the requirement.

The table below describes each icon in the image above.

1.		<b>Orange dash icon</b>	when next to a module item, the module item is overdue. When next to the module heading, the module requirements have not been met
2.		<b>Green check mark</b>	the module item has been completed. For requirements, this icon means the module requirement has been met
3.		<b>Blue info icon</b>	the module item has been submitted, but has not yet been graded.

4.		<b>Options label</b>	the module item requires you to choose an assignment path before additional module items can be displayed
5.		<b>White circle</b>	the module item has not been started
6.		<b>Lock icon</b>	the module is locked until a future date. For prerequisites, this icon means the previous module has not been completed so it cannot be viewed
7.	 <i>Locked until</i>	<b>Lock message</b>	the module may contain additional information that cannot be accessed until the name of the assignment in the message is graded.
