- "Request to Provide Public Comment" cards will be available for in-person attendees prior to the public input session for sign-up and must be submitted prior to the opening of the session.

Public comment will be conducted in accord with the Board of Education policy [Public Participation at Board Open Meetings or Public Hearings](#) and as summarized below:

- Each speaker shall be limited to no more than three (3) minutes. Speakers must state his or her name.
- All comments will be submitted with the decorum and respect appropriate to the conduct of public business.
- Topics such as personnel matters, pending appeals, specific student disciplinary matters or which constitute commercial solicitations are not permitted. **The only topic being discussed at this session is the “HCPS School Calendar.”**
- Disparaging comments, personal attacks, and inflammatory remarks about specific schools, personnel, any person, or group are not permitted. Speakers who engage in these comments will be reminded of the rules and the speaker may be removed. In addition, public comment is an opportunity for members of the community to address the Superintendent and the Board of Education. Please direct your comments to them and not to other members of the public in the audience.
- All public comments submitted will be part of the records maintained by the Board office.

Speakers are reminded that public comments are considered public information and, as such, are subject to the Maryland Public Information Act.
