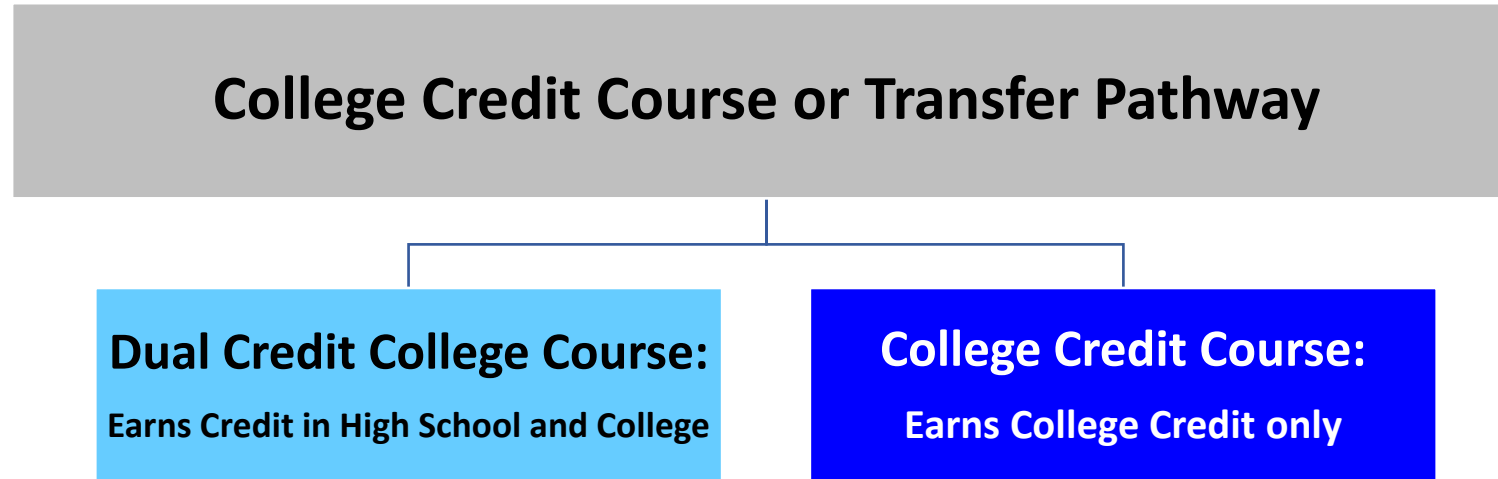

HCPS – HCC Dual Enrollment



Where can I take the courses?

- HCC Campus
- Online (through HCC Blackboard)
- High School (limited number of courses available in a high school)

Contact your school counselor for options.

Dual Enrollment Costs: **FREE***

- *Eligible students can participate in courses at no cost to the student.
 - **HCPS pays the following costs.**
 - Tuition[^]
 - Fees: consolidated, course, and direct access
 - Textbooks(s) through the HCC Rental Program
- *Eligibility requirements are as follows:
 - Meets College Career Ready (CCR) Standard**OR**
 - Meets Grade Point Average (GPA) 2.0+ (unweighted) and 90% attendance.

Note: HCPS may waive these requirements due to extenuating circumstances.

What is the process?

Step 1: HCPS APPLICATION

- Meet with School Counselor.
- Complete Application for Approval through <https://studentplanner.hcps.org/>.
- Wait approximately 5-7 business days for HCPS approval email notification.

Step 2: HCPS APPROVED

- Wait approximately 3-5 business days from HCPS approval to receive HCC email notification regarding admission.
- Monitor your HCPS email for notification and follow directions from the HCC notification for next steps.

Step 3: HCC ACCEPTED AND REGISTRATION

- Create your HCC OwlNet account from directions found in your acceptance email.
- Contact your HCC admission advisor to complete HCC registration process.
- Contact/go to HCC Bookstore to get textbooks. HCPS covers the cost through the HCC rental agreement.

Step 4: HCC REGISTERED AND HAVE BOOK(S)

- Use HCC Blackboard and OwlNet to monitor course assignments, grades.
- Adhere to the HCC Academic Calendar for important dates.
- Communicate with HCC teacher about absences from classes and/or assignments or other support needed.
