DECISION ON MAINTENANCE OF VIDEO SURVEILLANCE SYSTEMS

June 27, 2016

Background Information:

On behalf of the Office of Safety and Security, the Purchasing Department is requesting approval to award a contract to Skyline Network Engineering, LLC, doing business as, Skyline Technology Solutions located at 6956-F Aviation Boulevard, Glen Burnie, Maryland 21061 for the maintenance and repairs of video surveillance systems located throughout Harford County Public Schools.

Discussion:

Skyline Technology Solutions currently provides maintenance and repairs for video surveillance systems located throughout the school system which now includes 2031 cameras. Harford County Public Schools piggybacks Anne Arundel County Government's contract from RFP# 09-106R. The current maintenance agreement for Harford County Public Schools ends on July 13, 2016. The new maintenance agreement would cover the period of July 14, 2016 through July 13, 2017 with an estimated annual cost of \$218,793.00. This includes software updates, maintaining software on servers, PC's, and web client for remote access, updating sitemaps, annual preventative maintenance on equipment, and labor for all repairs. Additional cameras and related equipment are purchased as needed at discounted contract pricing.

The funding source for this contract is the operating budget of the Office of Safety and Security.

Superintendent's Recommendation:

The Superintendent of Schools recommends that the Board of Education accept the recommendation made by the Purchasing Department and award a contract to Skyline Technology Solutions of Glen Burnie, Maryland.
