QUARTER ONE PERFORMANCE REVIEW
DECEMBER 21, 2020

Background Information

Every school year, Harford County Public Schools (HCPS) monitors student performance through a variety of data including, but not limited to student enrollment, student attendance, reading and mathematics assessments, and report card grades. Due to the disruption caused by the global COVID19 Pandemic, most teaching and learning has been conducted in the virtual environment for the first quarter of the 2020-21 school year; therefore, this presentation focuses on these academic and accountability measures as they relate to first quarter metrics.

Discussion

Key findings from the data review of student enrollment, attendance, achievement on reading and mathematics assessments, and report card grades will be presented. The data was compared to the end of the first quarter in the 2019-20 school year where applicable, as well as disaggregated by gender, race/ethnicity, and student service groups which include English Language Learners (ELL), students receiving free or reduced meals (FARMS), and students with disabilities (SWD).
