**DECISION ON CONTRACT AWARD FOR VIDEO SURVEILLANCE EQUIPMENT
FOR JOPPATOWNE HIGH SCHOOL**

Background Information:

The Purchasing Department, on behalf of the Safety and Security Department, is requesting approval to award a contract to Skyline Technology Solutions located at 6956-F Aviation Blvd, Glen Burnie, MD 21061, in the amount of \$169,677.83. This contract is for the purchase of video surveillance equipment for the limited renovation project at Joppatowne High School.

Discussion:

This purchase will provide high-definition cameras throughout the building as well as on the exterior of the building and around the press box in the stadium. Additionally, video intercoms for outside the front door and new card readers are being purchased that will tie to the video management system. The updated video management system will allow school staff to monitor if doors are opened or closed, locked, or unlocked and view any of the cameras, which will provide better situational awareness for school staff.

The contracting vehicle for this project is Carroll County Public Schools contract #49-F-1-18/19.

The funding source for this purchase is the Joppatowne High School Limited Renovation – Capital Budget.

Superintendent's Recommendation:

The Superintendent of Schools recommends that the Board of Education accept the recommendation made by the Purchasing Department and award the contract to Skyline Technology Solutions in the amount of \$169,677.83

This contract is effective through November 30, 2021 with the option to renew for two (2) additional one (1) year terms, which will extend the contract through July 31, 2023.
