**DECISION ON CONTRACT AWARD FOR SECURITY CAMERA UPGRADE FOR
MULTIPLE LOCATIONS**

Background Information:

The Purchasing Department, on behalf of the Safety and Security Department, is requesting approval to award a contract to Skyline Technology Solutions located at 6956-F Aviation Blvd, Glen Burnie, MD 21061, in the amount of \$145,317.84. This contract is for the purchase and installation of security cameras for multiple school buildings throughout the district.

Discussion:

This purchase will cover the replacement of ninety-nine (99) interior and fifty (50) exterior cameras. During a recent audit, these cameras were flagged as a security risk due to having only basic authentication capabilities because of the equipment age. The cameras will be replaced at the following schools: Bel Air Middle and High, Fallston Middle, Fountain Green Elementary, Harford Tech High, Joppatowne Elementary, Magnolia Middle, Norrisville Elementary, North Harford Middle and High, Patterson Mill Middle/High, Southampton Middle, and William Paca Elementary. The contract includes removal and disposal of the existing cameras as well as delivery and installation of the new cameras.

The contracting vehicle for this project is Carroll County Public Network Consulting and Technical Services contract #49-F-1-18/19.

Funding for this purchase is the Safety and Security Department's FY21 Operating Budget.

Superintendent's Recommendation:

The Superintendent of Schools recommends that the Board of Education accept the recommendation made by the Purchasing Department and award the contract to Skyline Technology Solutions in the amount of \$145,317.84

This contract is effective through November 30, 2021 with the option to renew for two (2) additional one (1) year terms, which will extend the contract through July 31, 2023.
