Background Information:

The Board Ethics Policy provides for a five member Ethics Panel to implement the Board Ethics Policy. The members of this Panel are persons selected by the Board and who are not employed by the Board. There is one vacancy with respect to the panel. This vacancy occurred in June 2021, when Pastor Robert Condict resigned.

Discussion:

In June 2021, Pastor Robert Condict notified Patrick Spicer, Esquire, Board General Counsel and liaison to the Ethics Panel, that he no longer wished to serve on the Board's Ethics Panel and submitted his resignation on that date. Dr. Dennis Golladay, the recommended candidate, was previously interviewed for the Ethics Panel and was deemed well-qualified. Dr. Golladay was notified of the current vacancy and has agreed to serve on the Ethics Panel. Dr. Golladay has served his professional career in education for 53 years, starting as a seventh grade English and History teacher and concluding his career as President of Harford Community College from 2010-2016.
