




Safety and Security Committee Charter

To serve as liaison from the community to provide input, review procedures, and focus on the safety of the school population.



Charges to the Safety and Security Committee

- Review individual school critical incident plans and conduct on-site assessments.
- Study the feasibility of the implementation of early notification to parents/custodians of student absence.




Accomplishments

- Assessed six schools during the 2015-16 school year

General findings:


- Main entrance access control very good;
- Employees consistently wear badges;
- Unoccupied classrooms/portables left unsecured;
- Cafeteria doors being propped open; and
- Exterior doors failing to latch.

*Identified problems were corrected at the school level.




Recommendations

- Conduct a comprehensive review of a minimum of nine schools for 2016-17 school year.
- Defer the Superintendent's Leadership Subcommittee to decide to notify parents of student absence at 5:15pm.



Proposed Charge 2016-17

- Conduct a comprehensive review of critical incident plans for a minimum of nine schools to include three elementary, three middle, and three high.
- Research other school district's critical incident response options for school staff, teachers, and students.
