Background Information:

The current scoreboard located in the gym at North Harford Middle School is outdated and is in need of replacement. When desired, this requirement becomes the responsibility of the local school community and is coordinated under the HCPS School/Organization Sponsored Project process.

Discussion:

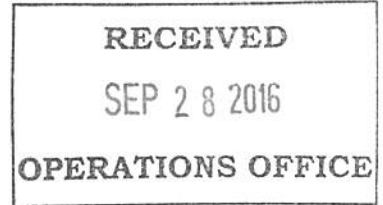
The North Harford Recreation Council is seeking approval to procure and install a new LED powered scoreboard, with wireless controls, fully functioning clock and buzzer in the gym at North Harford Middle School. The location for this new scoreboard will be in the same location as the existing scoreboard. The work of this project will be performed by Bostic Electric, a Harford County licensed electrical contractor. The work will be jointly managed by the North Harford Middle School administrative staff members and the North Harford Recreation Council. Observation and inspection will be performed by the HCPS Facilities Department and the Harford County Government's Department of Inspections, Licenses and Permits to ensure compliance with codes and standards.

Funds for this project have been contributed by the North Harford Recreation Council.

All of the necessary documentation has been submitted, reviewed, and approved by the appropriate school system staff, with comments through the Assistant Superintendent for Operations, as required by school system procedures. The cost associated with this request is as follows:

The Superintendent of Schools recommends that the Board of Education approve the request by North Harford Middle School community to procure and install a replacement scoreboard in the amount of \$5,000.00.

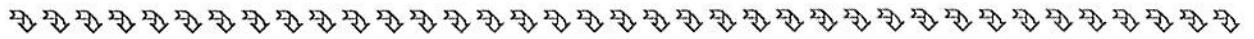

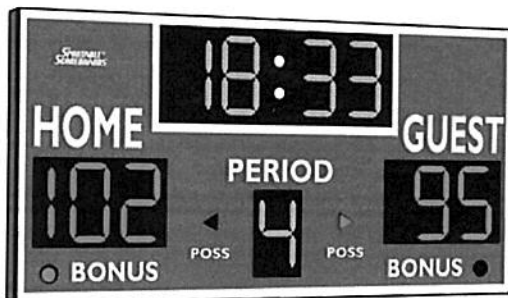
