DECISION ON AWARD OF CONTRACT NORTH HARFORD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FUEL TANK REMOVAL PROJECT

June 9, 2025

Background Information:

Bid documents for the North Harford Elementary School Fuel Tank Removal Project were issued and advertised during the month of March 2025. Bids were received and opened on May 23, 2025. Funding in the amount of Four Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$478,000.00), was provided by the County for this project in FY25.

Discussion:

Three (3) contractors submitted bids for the project. Towson Mechanical, Inc. submitted the responsive and responsible low base bid in the amount of Two Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$248,000.00) and recommended Alternate #1 in the amount of One Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$159,000.00). A bid tabulation is attached. Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) participation on this project will have an overall goal of 10%, with no subgoals.

Superintendent's Recommendation:

The Superintendent of Schools recommends that the Board of Education approve a contract for the above-described construction services for the North Harford Elementary School Fuel Tank Removal Project, in the amount of Four Hundred Seven Thousand Dollars (\$407,000.00) to Towson Mechanical, Inc. The amount of the award is the sum of the base bid and accepted Alternate #1.
