PRESENTATION OF DRAFT 2025-2026 HCPS SYNCHRONOUS

INSTRUCTION PLAN FOR INCLEMENT WEATHER DAYS

August 18, 2025

Background Information:

The Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) allows districts to utilize virtual instruction on inclement weather days. To do so, districts must use all built in <u>in-person</u> inclement weather days and must include 4 hours of <u>synchronous</u> instruction. MSDE requires at least 3 traditional inclement weather days to be included in district calendars for waivers of the 180-day requirement. If HCPS elects to utilize virtual instruction on inclement weather days, a plan must be approved by the Board of Education after public review.

Discussion:

This presentation, along with the attached materials, provides the Board with a draft instructional plan for implementing synchronous virtual instruction on inclement weather days. It includes survey data (with a public dashboard available Monday, August 18) and background information on state requirements and operational logistics. The purpose is to share the plan and survey results for a 30-day public feedback period in advance of potential adoption for the 2025–2026 school year. This information considers instructional delivery during inclement weather while addressing logistical factors identified through stakeholder feedback.
