DECISION ON
CONTRACT AWARD FOR THE REBUILD OF THE HICKORY ANNEX
RECEIVING BUILDING
MARCH 21, 2016

Background Information:

On behalf of the Facilities Department, the Purchasing Department is requesting approval to award a contract to Hayes Construction Company, 14307 Jarrettsville Pike, Phoenix, Maryland 21131, in the amount of \$131,137.90 for the rebuild of the Hickory Annex Receiving Building.

Discussion:

Due to fire damage on November 23, 2015, the Receiving Building located at the Hickory Annex requires rebuilding. This is the last phase of a three phase process. Phase I consisted of roof framing stabilization and covering of the exposed roof section. Phase II was for the removal of content, all necessary interior demolition and soda blasting of the interior perimeter walls and roof framing. Phase III entails the reconstruction of the structural and mechanical portion of the building.

The contracting vehicle for this project is Bid #JMI-609-13, Baltimore County Public Schools, Contracted Services: Building Renovations – Alterations.

The funding source for this project is from the FY16 Facilities Operating Account, with full future reimbursement from our insurance company, Maryland Association of Boards of Education (MABE).

The contractor is in compliance with the established MBE goals for this work.

Superintendent's Recommendation:

The Superintendent of Schools recommends that the Board of Education approve the award of the contract to Hayes Construction Company, in the amount of \$131,137.90.
