## I. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to authorize transfers for students in Title I schools under specified circumstances in accordance with the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB).

## **II.** Policy Statement

- A. All students enrolled in Title I schools as designated pursuant to the NCLB, and which are identified for either school improvement, corrective action or restructuring under the NCLB, shall be provided with the option to transfer to another public school in Harford County which has not been identified for school improvement, corrective action, restructuring nor as an unsafe school as defined under the NCLB.
- B. Transportation for students who exercise the transfer option described in II.A above shall be provided in accordance with the NCLB.
