**TOPIC**: <u>Services available through DORS for transitioning youth</u> **Speaker**: Jan Stauffer, Rehabilitation Counselor for DORS (Dept of Rehabilitative Services)

- **DORS** offers <u>Pre-Employment Services</u> (Pre-ETS) that helps transitioning youth "get ready to get a job." Pre-ETS is for students at least 14 years old and no more than 21. There is an application that must be completed and submitted along with documentation. <u>Website</u>: www.DORS.maryland.gov
- Job exploration counseling (what does person do well, what do they like, what do they not like)
- Work Employment Services (learn to be an employee and learn how to interact with other people in a work environment)
- Counseling for Transition Services (instruction in self-advocacy, such as, "how do I access accommodations without disclosing a disability")
- At school, parents can ask their TRI (Transition Resource Itinerant) to include DORS in the child's transition plan
- Job training starts at home. Suggestions assign chores, have child do things by themselves \*\* <u>It is important to foster independence to whatever level they can achieve</u>.
- <u>Vocational Rehabilitation</u> (VR) services are offered for adults and students beginning in their next to last year of high school.
