Kelly Nelson gave a slide presentation on how Maryland ABLE can help families save and invest in a tax-free account for a special-needs person without them losing state or local benefits.

Current (2019) contribution limit for Maryland ABLE accounts is \$15,000.

The ABLE to Work Act also allows the person to save (for 2019) an additional \$12,140 of money earned from a job
