



Certified Logistics Associate and Certified Logistics Technician

2025-2026

This program examines the role of supply chain logistics in the economy and explains the importance of warehousing. Understanding how logistics works and how it can be an asset in the implementation of supply is the focus of this training. Through Manufacturing Skill Standards Council (MSSC) certifications, students will demonstrate mastery of the core competencies of material handling at the front-line (entry-level to front-line supervisor) through successful completion of the logistics certification assessments. Students may complete a one-day training that includes both classroom and hands-on training for first-time forklift drivers. The Forklift training is for students 18 and older.

Cost: the course is free, and transportation provided if needed

Required courses:

- Job Readiness
- Certified Logistics Associate
- Certified Logistics Technician
- Forklift training (optional)

Certifications: Certified Logistics Associate (CLA), Certified Logistics Technician (CLT), and optional forklift training
