Dental Assistant

Students in the Dental Assistant program will learn dental terminology, disease transmission, disinfection and sterilization, dental anatomy, dental records and charting, instrumentation, impressions and castings, radiation health and safety, insurance, and billing front desk responsibilities. This course also provides x-ray training that qualifies you to sit for the Dental Assisting National Board (DANB) Radiation Health and Safety Examination. This course does not include a clinical component. Students will have the option to take the clinical course with Harford Community College within six months of completing this course. Students must be 17 years old to participate.



Requirements

- Must be 17 years old
- Must pass the Accuplacer exam (NGA and NGR) at the HCC testing center prior to enrollment.
- This course will require hours outside of the traditional school day.
