THE GED® TEST

The GED® test is a high school equivalency exam of four modules of high school level courses offered on computer at authorized GED® testing centers. The test is available in English and Spanish; however, the *Reasoning through Language Arts* module must be taken in English. If requesting GED® test accommodations, check the appropriate box during the registration process. Instructions will be provided.

- Mathematical Reasoning (Math)
- Reasoning through Language Arts (RLA)
- Science
- Social Studies

ELIGIBILITY- AGE

Home School students, ages 16 to 18, must submit the completed and signed *GED Office Home Instruction Verification Form* found at https://www.dllr.state.md.us/gedmd/ged.shtml EMail to the Maryland GED office for a waiver.

ELIGIBILITY-ID

Candidates must reside in Maryland. Bring one of the following when you test:

- Valid (not expired) Maryland Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA) Driver's License or Learner's Permit
- MD MVA Identification (ID) Card
- Active Duty Military Dependent's Identification Card
- Passport or other government issued identification AND proof of residency such as a school ID, a copy of the completed Verification form, insurance card, medical record

REGISTERING AND SCHEDULING AN EXAM

- 1. Go to www.ged.com to create an account.
- 2. Once approved, schedule by selecting a convenient test center and time: https://ged.com/about_test/scheduling
- 3. Pay with any major credit card, debit card, or gift card. There is a Maryland subsidy for the first attempt of each module. With the code MDGED1875, the fee is \$11.25. Two retests are discounted at \$10.00 per module.

Note: Online Proctored testing is available only to eligible testers 18 and older.
