Drug dog scans conducted at Edgewood Middle and Edgewood High schools

Two routine, random drug dog scans were performed at Edgewood Middle and Edgewood High schools yesterday, November 9th. The scans, done as part of the school system's commitment to keeping illicit drugs out of the schools, were accomplished using a canine under the direction of the Edgewood Police Department.

The Edgewood Middle scan involved 289 lockers being sniffed by the dog. The 20-minute scan – supervised by four Harford County Sherriff's Officers, one drug dog, three administrators from the school, and the school system's Coordinator of Safety and Security – resulted in one alert producing no controlled dangerous substances.

The Edgewood High School scan involved 384 lockers being sniffed by the dog. The 15-minute scan – supervised by four Harford County Sherriff's Officers, one drug dog, three administrators from the school, and the school system's Coordinator of Safety and Security – resulted in no alerts.
