Advocate for the Harford County Public Schools FY19 Operating Budget

Harford County Public Schools will host the Superintendent’s Virtual Budget Town Hall on Monday, November 6, 2017, from 4:30 to 6:00 p.m. The Virtual Town Hall will be LIVE streamed via the school system’s website, www.hcps.org, as well as archived for later viewing.

Superintendent of Schools Barbara Canavan will be joined by members of her Budget Office and will discuss the priorities for the 2018-2019 Harford County Public Schools Operating Budget.
