Drug dog scans conducted at C. Milton Wright High School

Two routine, random drug dog scans were performed at C. Milton Wright High School this morning. The scans, done as part of the school system's commitment to keeping illicit drugs out of the schools, were accomplished using a canine under the direction of the Harford County Sheriff's Office.

The C. Milton Wright High School scan involved 508 lockers being sniffed by the dog. The 20-minute scan – supervised by five deputies from the Harford County Sherriff's Office, one drug dog, two administrators from the school, and the school system's Coordinator of Safety and Security – resulted in one alert producing no controlled dangerous substances.

In addition, nine vehicles in the school's parking lot were scanned. The 35-minute scan – supervised by four deputies from the Harford County Sheriff's Office, one drug dog, one school administrator, and the school system's Coordinator of Safety and Security – resulted in two alerts and produced one controlled dangerous substance.
