


Using Naviance Student, you can help your student prepare for success after high school. Use this quick guide to get started with the tools described below.

Career Planning and Assessments

- To access the Career Planning tools in Naviance Student, log in and navigate to the Career section.
- To view the results of your student's assessments, log in and navigate to the About Me section. Assessment results for completed assessments can be found in the My Assessments section.



The **StrengthsExplorer** assessment identifies your student's three strongest talents and provides an explanation of each theme. Students learn how to capitalize on their success and discover what they need to do next to continue building on their strengths.



The Career Interest Profiler lists your student's interests as they relate to work activities.

Watch Roadtrip Nation Videos

The Roadtrip Nation Interview Archive in Naviance Student contains more than 5,000 video interviews of leaders who have turned their interests into their life's work.

To explore the Roadtrip Nation Interview Archive:

- 1. Navigate to the **Careers** section in Naviance Student.
- 2. Select **Road Trip Nation** to begin searching the archive.

College Planning

To access the College Planning tools in Naviance Student, log in and navigate to the **Colleges** section.

To **search** for colleges:

- 1. Select **SuperMatch™ College Search** in the **Find Your Fit** section.
- Use the Choose Fit Criteria filters to search for your best college matches, pin your favorites, and compare schools side by side.



To view results:
