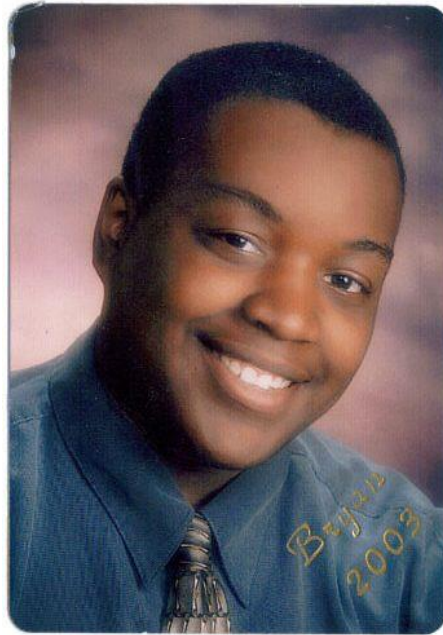


The Bryan Michael Burnett Scholarship Foundation, Inc.
