

Senior Recovery Program

Program Description

The Harford County Public Schools (HCPS) Senior Recovery Program provides current high school seniors with expanded access to curricula aligned to the Maryland College Career Readiness Standards. Students will sit for the appropriate graduation assessment exam(s) at the end of the summer program if offered by the Maryland State Department of Education. Teachers will be hired to teach Mathematics, English, Science, and Social Studies courses in a blended learning setting. One teacher from each content area will be hired. Each teacher will work two days per week.

Mathematics and English- **Mondays and Wednesdays**

Science and Social Studies- **Tuesdays and Thursdays**
