### **Program Description**

The Extended School Year (ESY) program assists students with disabilities in maintaining the skills at risk of regression and attain the critical life skills or self-sufficiency goals essential to continued progress and development.

The Extended School Year (ESY) Elementary Program provides a continuum of special education and related services to students receiving instruction at Harford Academy or Swan Creek School. Staff will support the planning and implementation of student Individualized Education Programs (IEPS) June 24<sup>th</sup> – August 1<sup>st</sup>.

*\* ESY will be offered through virtual instruction only for Swan Creek school students*
