



Student Device Service Plan Option

Per the Student Device Agreement, your student has been provided a device to use for instructional purposes. As noted in that agreement, in accordance with Board of Education policy, Use of Equipment/Materials by Students, the parent/guardian is responsible for all damage or loss to an HCPS owned device.

Harford County Public Schools is offering the option to purchase a device service plan for \$20 through October 8, 2021. This purchase will cover the cost of repair only if the device is returned and the service tag is visible. The fee is per device, per student for the FY2021-2022 school year and is non-refundable.

If the device service plan is not elected and paid in full, the cost for repair is \$150 per device, per incident. Replacement costs for a device beyond repair, lost, or stolen are:

- Charger - \$36
- Chromebook/laptop - \$300
- Dell Precision 5550 laptop - \$1,750
- Apple iPad - \$399

Harford County Public Schools may utilize a collection agency to recoup this cost. Also note that Harford County Public Schools reserves the right to hold a student and family fully accountable for 100% of the damages should there be repeated willful and malicious damage.

Please note: the student device must be returned at the conclusion of the school year. Any device not returned will generate a replacement charge listed above.
